

Acrylic Nailfinity Sculpting

Service Time





1 Antiseptic

Wash client's hands thoroughly and dry with a towel. Use an antiseptic agent on the client's hands to eliminate any risk of infection.

Remove any nail polish.



2 Free Edge

Shorten the length of the natural nail using the 180/180 White Turtle File.



3 Express Manicure

Apply a small amount of *K-Cuticle Remover* around the cuticle area.

Use the rounded end of the *K-Edge Pusher* to very gently push back the cuticle and to remove all non-living tissue. Rinse thoroughly with water.

Use the *K-Cuticle Nipper* to carefully cut off excess non-living tissue or hangnails.



4 Nail Preparation

Use the *K-File White Turtle File 180/180* to remove shine from the natural nail.

Remove any dust from the entire nail surface using the dust brush.

Apply *K-Dehydrator* to remove moisture and oils from the natural nail plate.









Affix the form underneath the free edge of the natural nail. Secure it by sticking the corner front tabs and the rear of the form in place. Make sure the form is fixed and still. Note: If you accidentally touch the natural nail surface or more than 30 minutes pass between form application and sculpting, use *K-Dehydrator* again.



6 K-Primer Acid

Dip the brush into *K-Primer Acid* and blot it on a paper towel before application.

Apply the primer sparingly, starting 1 mm from the cuticle area and making sure the primer does not touch the skin or cuticle.

Apply primer to all 5 nails using the primer that remains on the brush.

Make sure it dries completely.



7 K-Monomer

Fill 2/3 of the dappen dish with *K-Monomer*. Completely dip the body of the *K-Brush Salon #8* into the *K-Monomer* and press it against the bottom of the dappen dish to remove any air bubbles.

Remove the brush from the dappen dish by slightly blotting it against the dappen dish's sides to move the monomer down towards the tip of the brush. Make sure sufficient monomer is left in the tip of brush for sculpting.







8 K-F

K-Polymer Nailfinity

Pick up a bead of *K-Polymer Nailfinity* and make sure it has the correct mix ratio. A good bead does not have any polymer particles around it, does not drip liquid, and has a wet, smooth, shiny look.

Free Edge

Place a large-sized bead between the free edge of the natural nail and the nail form. Work with the body of the brush in reverse technique and form a smile line by spreading material to the right and to the left. Leave a thicker layer at the smile line edge.

Continue in reverse technique, blending in toward the cuticle area.

Cuticle

Place another, smaller-sized bead at the cuticle area and press from side to side to finish in a thin edge along the cuticle area. Use long strokes toward the smile line with the remaining material to cover the entire nail surface with the same shade.

K-Polymer Dynamite White

Pick up a bead of *K-Polymer Dynamite White* and make sure it has the correct mix ratio.

Place a medium-sized white bead in the middle of the free edge of the nail (Zone 1). Spread the bead evenly to the right and left, forming a smile line. Use the tip of the brush and make tiny motions to sculpt the product, creating a deep smile line.

K-Polymer Crystalline

Place a bead of *K-Polymer Crystalline* to create a correct stress point and smooth the nail surface where necessary.









Using the *K-File Zebra Ziggy 120/180*, fix the shape of the free edge, then refine the nail surface, and, if required, refine the shape again.

Refine the lower arches using the *K-File Krazy Kat 150/180* and finish by buffing the entire surface using the *K-Sponge Funny Penguin 240/240*, removing all scratches.

Remove dust from the entire nail surface using the dust brush.

Continue with black, white, and grey sides of the *K-File Snake Shiner* and buff the entire surface of the nail.



12 K-Solar Shield

Apply 2 coats of K-Solar Shield to optically enhance the white free edge and permanently protect it from yellowing.



13 K-Cuticle Oil

Wash client's hands thoroughly and dry with a towel. Finish by moisturizing with a drop of *K-Aromatic Cuticle Oil* at the cuticle, gently massaging using rounded motions.
